

## Key Updates week ending Friday, May 21, 2021

**Update: FRCOG Drive-thru at Greenfield Community College open until May 25th** - The FRCOG drive-thru clinic at GCC has second dose clinics scheduled until Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>. We have two clinics left and are regularly drawing extra doses of vaccine. All remaining clinics now accept walk-in appointments, no pre-registration necessary! Because we are not planning any drive-thru clinics at GCC past Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, all those who receive first dose appointments at our remaining clinics are being assisted with scheduling second dose appointments elsewhere. **Regional Collaborative Clinic Data** – On May 20<sup>th</sup>, 60% (~42,000) people living in Franklin County have had their first shot and 46% of residents (32,000) are fully vaccinated\*. This week, between Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, FRCOG drive-thru clinics at GCC will have given approximately 2,500 additional vaccinations.

**Sunday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, One-and-Done J&J Clinic at Charlemont Fairgrounds** – This clinic is hosted by the Hawlemont Emergency Dispensing Site Team and offers Johnson and Johnson's single dose Janssen vaccine. This drive-thru clinic at the Charlemont Fairgrounds is located off of North Heath Road in Charlemont by the Bissell Covered Bridge ([directions](#)). The clinic opens at 10 a.m., Sunday June 13<sup>th</sup>.
